INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the British Baseball Federation South Yearbook for 1988. This is the second year in which we have gathered all the essential information about the BBFS into a booklet, and I think you will agree that it has proved extremely useful. If you are reading this and would like to get involved in baseball, please feel free to contact any of the Executive, or your nearest club, or the BBFS Umpires Association (see P.4).

The spectacular growth in the size of our league that was triggered by Channel 4's coverage of the 1986 Major League post-season has continued throughout 1987 and 1988. In 1986 we had 23 senior teams; in 1987, 30; this year, 42 teams will start the season. We have virtually doubled in size in eighteen months. With the Youth Instructional League entering its second year, we have 51 teams overall.

The Constitutional Committee under Glenn Libby has worked hard over the winter to create a shape for this explosion in baseball participation, and evidence of their innovations can be seen on the schedule pages of this book, and on pages 2 and 3. For the first time in recent years we have taken a bard look at ourselves, set some goals, and changed the way the League operates in order to achieve those goals. The main purpose is to raise the standard of British baseball in order to produce a national team that can perform creditably at Olympic level; the means chosen to this end is simply to play more baseball. Thus the number of games has been raised, by the addition of doubleheaders and some extra dates, from 12 or 14 to between 21 and 24, depending on divison. This expanded schedule will put extra pressure on playing facilities, on players, on managers, and on umpires. If we all try to be as politic, patient, punctual, efficient and communicative as possible this summer, then by September we will be wondering why we never did something like this before.

It is likely that once again the National Club Championship Final will be held at the Oval. Last year's Final, despite a late start in planning and promotion, lack of initial capital, and the relative inexperience of most of the organisers, was a great success, if not a profit making one. Much was learned about sports promotion, and work is already underway to ensure that the lessons learned enable us to have an even greater success this year.

'Grand Slam', our fortnightly newsletter, filled a longstanding gap last year, and, with your contributions, can be even better this year. So send your game reports, feature articles, cartoons, letters, artwork, photos, gossip and jokes to the Press Officer for inclusion.

Finally I would like to thank Slick Willie's American Sport Shop for sponsoring the Yearbook for the second year in a row. I hope our relationship is a long and mutually beneficial one. I would also like to thank the Press Officer for compiling the Yearbook, Chris Ryan for supervising the printing, and Jason Godfrey for designing the cover. Play Ball!

SCHEDULE EXPLANATION AND RULES FOR PROMOTION AND RELEGATION

DOUBLEHEADERS

On the schedule pages, the designation (2) means that a doubleheader will be played on that date. All other fixtures are single games.

THE GROUP ROUND

At the end of the 'schedule' round (July 31st), every team will have a definite place in their division or conference standings (tie-breaker criteria will be used where necessary). Thus, for example, in the 1st Division Group Round fixtures, the number 1 will represent the team which was top of the table after July 31st, the number 2 will represent the team which was second, etc.. The exact form of the Group Round will vary from division to division, from conference to conference;

- The 1st and 2nd Divisions will both split into two groups, 1st place to 4th place and 5th place to eighth place, and each team will play a single game against each of the three other teams in their group.
- The 3rd Division North will split into two groups, 1st place to 4th place and 5th place to 10th place, and each team will play a single game against every other team in their group. This means that the bottom six teams after the schedule round will play two more games than the top four teams this is unavoidable in a ten team conference if the principles of the Group Round are adhered to.
- The 3rd Division Central and South will split into two groups of four, like the 1st and 2nd Divisions, but each team will play an extra doubleheader against the team closest to them in the standings (1 v 2, 3 v 4, etc) before playing a doubleheader against each team in their group.

PROMOTION AND RELEGATION

- 1. Between 1st Division and 2nd Division; The last place team in Div.1 is relegated. The first place team from Dvi.2 is promoted. There will be a best-of-three playoff series between the seventh place team in Div.1 and the second place team in Div.2, the winner of which remains in/is promoted to Div.1. The venue for the first two games will be decided on the toss of a coin; the third game, if necessary, will be played at the other team's ground.
- 2. Between 2nd Division and 3rd Division; There will be no relegation from the 2nd Division in 1988. Four teams will be promoted from the 3rd Division to the 2nd Division, thus enlarging the 2nd Divison from 8 to 12 teams for 1989. The four teams to be promoted will be the three Conference winners (North, Central and South), plus the winners of a Promotion Tournament between the second place teams from each conference and the team with the next best record from any conference. These four teams will meet on two dates; two single games will be played on the first date, and the winners of those two games will meet on the second date (venue to be decided by toss of coin) and play a single game for the fourth promotion place.

REGULATIONS FOR DOUBLEHEADERS

The following regulations will apply to the playing of doubleheaders in 1988;

- 1. Starting Time 13.30 (or earlier by agreement)
 - 14.30 when preceded by another league match.
- 2. Time Between Games 20 minutes (or less by agreement)
- 3. Time Limits -2 hrs 35 minutes for each game. No inning will start after this point unless the game is tied, in which case normal extra-inning rules will apply. Thus the maximum duration of a doubleheader will be $5\frac{1}{2}$ hours.
- Slaughter Rule Because of the time limits, the Slaughter Rule will not apply to doubleheaders.
- 5. Pitching Restrictions The following apply only to doubleheaders;
 - a. A pitcher may pitch any number of innings in one particular game.
 - b. A pitcher who completes 4 or more innings in the first game may not pitch more than 2 complete innings in the second game.
 - c. No pitcher may accumulate more than 9 full innings in the two games, however distributed.
- 6. Violation of Pitching Restrictions It is the responsibility of the opposing manager to bring violations of the pitching rules to the attention of the home plate umpire. A pitcher will be considered to have violated the rules if he throws one pitch in an inning above the prescribed limits. The penalty for violating these rules is automatic ejection from the game for the pitcher and his manager.
- Number of Innings Doubleheader games will be of seven innings duration. A double-header game called before seven innings are complete will be treated as a normal nine inning game, i.e., Rule 4.10 will apply.
