## INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the 1989 British Baseball Federation South Yearbook. Within these pages you will find most of what you need to know about our organisation for this year. If you have any further queries, do not hesitate to contact either myself or any of the members of the Executive Committee (see page 2) or the team nearest you.

The BBFS consists of Senior teams (any age, both sexes) and Youth teams (age 9 - 16, both sexes) and you can find listings for all of them in the Directory section. We also have a flourishing Umpires Association for those interested in officiating baseball (page 2).

We welcome anyone into our ranks - experienced players or absolute beginners, umpires, scorers or simply spectators. Our main goal is to provide as many people as possible with the opportunity to play or be involved in baseball.

In 1988, BBFS teams took all of the major trophies in British baseball. The Cobham Yankees won the National Club Championship for the third successive year. The Enfield Spartans won the National Knock-Out Cup and as a result they will be representing Great Britain this year in the European Cup at Reading.

Many of you will already know that baseball will be a fully recognised sport at the Barcelona Olympics in 1992. The Great Britain team succeeded in obtaining promotion to the European Qualifying Group 'A' by winning Group 'B' in Birmingham last year - many of the players who made up this highly successful team came from southern clubs.

The BBFS is one of 11 regional organisations affiliated to the sport's governing body in this country, the British Baseball Federation. We are one of the largest baseball organisations in Europe and we're over three times bigger than the next largest region in the UK. To participate in our league, we merely ask that playing fields and equipment are to a suitable standard and that registration fees have been paid.

1988 was a particularly exciting year for the BBFS. On behalf of the Executive Committee, let me take this opportunity to wish you all a very enjoyable 1989, whether you are playing, umpiring, or just watching the greatest team sport in the world - BASEBALL!

**SCHEDULE EXPLANATION:  
RULES FOR PROMOTION  
and RELEGATION**

**STARTING TIMES** - Single games will normally start at 3.00 pm. Double-headers will start at 1.30 pm (or earlier by agreement), or at 2.30 pm if there is a preceding game. Spectators should contact the home team for confirmation.

**DOUBLEHEADER REGULATIONS**

**Time Between Games** - 20 minutes (or less by agreement).

**Time Limits** - 2 hrs 35 minutes for each game. No complete inning shall start after this point unless the game is tied, in which case normal extra-inning rules will apply. Thus the maximum duration of a doubleheader will be 5 1/2 hours.

**Slaughter Rule** - Because of the time limits, the Slaughter Rule will not apply to doubleheaders.

**Pitching Restrictions** - The following will apply only to doubleheaders:

(1) A pitcher may pitch any number of innings in one particular game.

(2) A pitcher who completes 4 or more innings in the first game may not pitch more than 2 complete innings in the second game.

(3) No pitcher may accumulate more than 9 complete innings in the two games, however distributed.

**Violation of Pitching Restrictions** - It is the responsibility of the opposing manager to bring violations of the pitching rules to the attention of the home plate umpire. A pitcher will be considered to have violated the rules if he throws one pitch in an inning above the prescribed limits. The penalty for violating these rules is automatic ejection from the game for the pitcher and his manager.

**Number of Innings** - Doubleheader games will be of 7 innings duration. A doubleheader game called before 7 innings are complete will be treated as normal 9 inning game; i.e. Rule 4.10 will apply.

**PROMOTION AND RELEGATION**

**Between Division 1 and Division 2:** The 8th place team in Div. 1 will be relegated; the Champions of Div. 2 will be promoted. There will be a best-of-three playoff series for the other Div. 1 place between the 7th place team in Div. 1 and the runners-up in Div. 2.

**Between Division 2 and Division 3:** The 12th place team in Div. 2 will be relegated; The three conference champions and the team with the next best record from Div. 3 will contest a knock-out playoff tournament as follows (home team first);

**Game A:** Conf. Champ. with Best Record v 4th Team.

**Game B:** Conf. Champ. v Conf. Champ.

**Game C:** Winners Game A v Winners Game B.

**Game D:** Losers Game B v Losers Game A.

The winners of Game C will be promoted to Div. 2; the losers of Game C will play a single game v. the 11th place team in Div. 2 for a place in Div. 2; and the winners of Game D will play a single game v. the 10th place team in Div. 2 for a place in Div. 2.

**RESULTS GATHERING AND  
COMMUNICATIONS**

This year the Executive has decided to introduce an experimental system of results gathering and communication. In the past, all results have been phoned in to the Press Officer, whose responsibility it has then been to pass on the results and standings both to the clubs and to various press agencies. This system worked best in 1987 when 'Grand Slam' magazine was produced; but the amount of work it entailed was too much for the Press Officer alone to do, and GS, sadly, disappeared.

In 1989, much of this work will be delegated to Divisional Secretaries (see below) who will work with the Press Officer to provide a news service for the clubs in the form of fortnightly newsletters. Each division/conference will have a Secretary (two secretaries in the case of Division 2) and after games **BOTH TEAMS MUST PHONE IN THE RESULT TO THE APPROPRIATE DIVISIONAL SECRETARY BY 10 pm** (if you fail to get through by then, keep trying until you do). If you don't get your result in by 10 pm, it is highly unlikely that we will be able to get it to the Press Agencies in time for the newspapers - so it's up to you; if you want your club's results in the papers, get them to your Divisional Secretary early.
